

This document is intended to determine mixing instructions for smaller quantities of bleach used as a disinfectant when the instructions on the bottle are per gallon. This is not intended to be a standardized recipe for the mixing of bleach as a disinfectant.

When a product label instructs mixing $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
1/2 cup	1 Gallon
2 TBSP	1 Quart
1 TBSP	1 Pint

When a product label instructs mixing $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
3/4 Cup	1 Gallon
2 TBSP	1 Quart
1 TBSP	1 Pint

When a product label instructs mixing 1 cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
1 Cup	1 Gallon
4 TBSP	1 Quart
2 TBSP	1 Pint

When a product label instructs mixing 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of bleach per gallon of water:

<u>Amount of Bleach</u>	<u>Amount of Water</u>
1.5 cups	1 Gallon
6 TBSP	1 Quart
3 TBSP	1 Pint
