This document is intended to determine mixing instructions for smaller quantities of bleach used as a disinfectant when the instructions on the bottle are per gallon. This is not intended to be a standardized recipe for the mixing of bleach as a disinfectant.

When a product label instructs mixing $1 / 2$ cup of bleach per gallon of water:

| Amount of Bleach | Amount of Water |
| :--- | :--- |
| $1 / 2$ cup | 1 Gallon |
| 2 TBSP | 1 Quart |
| 1 TBSP | 1 Pint |

When a product label instructs mixing $3 / 4$ cup of bleach per gallon of water:

| Amount of Bleach | $\underline{\text { Amount of Water }}$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| $3 / 4$ Cup | 1 Gallon |
| 2 TBSP | 1 Quart |
| 1 TBSP | 1 Pint |

## When a product label instructs mixing 1 cup of bleach per gallon of water:

| Amount of Bleach | Amount of Water |
| :--- | :--- |
| 1 Cup | 1 Gallon |
| 4 TBSP | 1 Quart |
| 2 TBSP | 1 Pint |

When a product label instructs mixing $1 \frac{1}{2}$ cup of bleach per gallon of water:

| Amount of Bleach | $\underline{\text { Amount of Water }}$ |
| :--- | :--- |
| 1.5 cups | 1 Gallon |
| 6 TBSP | 1 Quart |
| 3 TBSP | 1 Pint |
